The Tennessee Department of Human Services, in cooperation with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, shall, by accessing the criminal registry files maintained by the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation, enter Social Security Number and the name of such applicant to verify the accuracy of the criminal violation information. If the Department finds such information has been falsified on the application, the Department shall notify the appropriate District Attorney of such violation (Act 1985, Chapter 478, Section 27).
